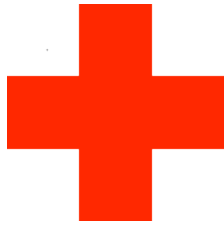


Federally-Funded Health Centers

- Check-ups when you are well

- Complete care when you are pregnant
- Immunizations and check-ups for children
- Mental Health and substance abuse counseling
- Breast/Cervical Cancer screening
